Applewood United Church must be a safe, inclusive, and respectful space for everyone who attends meetings, workshops, seminars, and special events anywhere on the church property indoors or outdoors, and when visiting off site on behalf of Applewood United Church. Therefore, the following code of conduct regarding language and content has been put in place. All participants should be made aware of why this code is important and agree to adhere to the following:

The language/content:

1. does not belittle anyone based on age, race, culture, faith tradition, gender and gender expression, sexual orientation, physical appearance, etc.
2. is not racist, sexist, homophobic, biphobic or transphobic.
3. does not reinforce stereotypes or labels.

If you hear language or content which is offensive to you, please contact the Minister or Affirming Committee members. Please know that any such communication will be dealt with seriously and confidentially.
